Please submit the abstract as a word document using Times New Roman font size 12 and 1.5 lines spacing. The abstract should be limited to 150 words.

The title should appear on the top of the document, in bold, centered and limited to 150 characters.

Names of the authors. The presenting author should be first with his/her name underlined. Please use superscript numbers^{1,2,3} if the authors have more than one affiliation

The affiliation of the different authors

Correspondence information: please include an updated E-mail address

Abstract

The abstract can be no more than 150 words.

Please keep it clear, interesting and short.
